IMPORTANT - Please let me know when you are unavailable to play. Contact Rod Snibson by text on 049 0207 487 or email rsnibson@melbpc.org.au. The success of the tournament depends on keeping the organiser informed about your unavailability each week, and having replacements ready.

PRIZES - No team can win two prizes in the same week.

- \$40 for the winners
- \$30 for second
- \$20 for best game
- The results are calculated with 20 points for a win, ten points for a draw and each winning end counts. If totals are equal, then both scores for each team are added. If this does not resolve the matter, a coin is tossed.

COMPETITION RULES

- No rollup
- Leads to roll the jack
- No dead ends – if the jack goes out it is placed on the centre line tee.
- Umpire is Rod Snibson
- 3 bowl nominated pairs
- 2 games of 11 ends – afternoon tea break after first game
- A player in a top side can only partner with a player in the lower division. A player in the second and third sides can play with anyone. People new to bowls can play too.
- Each pair stays together for the duration of the season, which is until the end of August. The game starts at 12.30pm and finishes around 4pm when Carmelo will award the prizes..

A list of the teams for each week will be displayed each week in the clubroom.

The games will be played on the top Green in the east west direction. Emergencies are very welcome. They keep the competition humming when regular players have a medical appointment or are unavailable.

A RECAP OF THE CLUB'S ONGOING COVID-SAFE PRACTICES

EVERY time you enter the clubroom, and before you touch any object or surface in the clubroom, please use the hand sanitiser provided to sanitise your hands.

Make sure your name is on the SIGN IN LIST list each time you come to the Club.

Only people with sanitised hands should enter the kitchen area and even then, there is to be only one person at a time in that area.

At the end of the day's play, the people playing on each rink are responsible for disinfecting the jack and mats that they used. In each of bowls cupboards on each Green there are disinfectant wipes for wiping the jack and a bottle of liquid disinfectant for spraying the mats, plus bottles of hand sanitiser. Used disinfectant wipes should be placed in the appropriately labelled bin on each Green.
